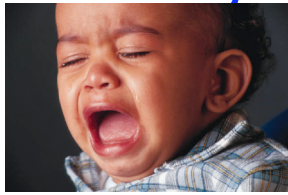


How are you going to beat those ol' Taxpayin' Blues?
